1.1 *Name and status of awarding institution:*

Universiteit Utrecht (state-recognized public research university)

1.2 *Name and status of institution administering studies:*

University College Utrecht (UCU)

1.3 *Language of instruction:*

English

2.1 *Official length of program of one semester:* 30 ECTS

(One year full-time study = 60 ECTS. 1 ECTS = 28 study hours)

2.2 *Level of qualification:* Bachelor's degree

2.3 *Course levels:* level 1 = introductory; level 2 = intermediate (sometimes with prerequisites); level 3 = advanced (always with prerequisites)

3.1 *Mode of study:*

Full-time, 4 courses of 7.5 ECTS each, per semester

Grading system

Unlike most Institutions of Higher Learning in the Netherlands, University College Utrecht uses the Anglo-

American grading system of letter grades (A-F) and grade points (0-4). The final GPA (Grade Point average) is calculated over the student's semesters.
